# Po Kwong Charity Walk

HHCKLA Buddhist Po Kwong School aims to provide quality education services for children with intellectual disabilities based on the principle of "equality for all living beings, teaching without discrimination." In addition to relying on basic government subsidies, the school needs to invest significant resources to enhance educational quality and assist students facing economic difficulties. These resources primarily come from fundraising and the generous support of donors. Over the years, with the enthusiastic donations from various sectors, the school has gained additional resources to offer a diverse learning environment for students with special learning needs, expanding their learning opportunities and continuously improving their educational effectiveness. We would like to express our heartfelt thanks to all donors.

We have always placed great importance on the learning and holistic development of our students. However, the school building is over twenty years old, and some facilities are showing signs of wear and tear. The school needs to update and expand resources to optimize school facilities. This year's Po Kwong Charity Walk, themed "**Walking Together with Compassion to Optimize the Campus for a Better Future**", aims to **enhance the campus environment, acquire and update teaching resources, inspire students' learning potential, and promote their overall development**.

## Groups

- **Health and Leisure Group:** Approximately 10 minutes of uphill walking
- **Named Sponsorship Progress Group:** Approximately 15 minutes of uphill walking
- **Named Sponsorship Challenge Group:** Approximately 30 minutes (includes an extra 800 stone steps, offering a panoramic view of the entire Fanling scenery. Due to the challenging nature of this route, there are only 30 spots available, allocated on a first-come, first-served basis. Once full, no additional registrations will be accepted.)

★Participants in the Challenge Group will receive notification of their group assignment upon checking in on the day of the event. If the group is already full at the time of registration, participants will be assigned to the Progress Group.
